## **Public Notice**

### **Invitation of applications for supply of, double distilled, spiced, pot-country liquor, of 50 degrees proof strength, in bottled form for the year 2006-2007**

Applications are invited from reputed distilleries located in Haryana, or in any other state, located within 200 kms. of the boundaries of Haryana State, for supply of **495 lakh proof litres** ( $\pm 20\%$ ) of double distilled, spiced, pot, country liquor of **50 degrees proof strength** in bottled form, to the licensed retail country liquor outlets in the State of Haryana, for the financial year 2006-2007.

It is likely that the licensed retail country liquor outlets may lift **additional quota of fifty percent** of the basic quota.

The conditions for applying for the supply of country liquor by distilleries are given below:-

1. Application giving name and location of the distillery (with full address)
2. Annual installed capacity in kilo litres
3. Production of country liquor in the last five years in proof litres.  
(in case of new distillery for the number of years the distillery is in operation)
4. Gross turnover of the distillery during last 5 yrs. (attach balance sheets)
5. Date of validity of manufacturing license.
6. Whether the distillery was blacklisted/challaned for any serious violations (if so give details)
7. Quantity of country liquor offered for supply every month.
8. Particulars of application fee of Rs. 10,000/- (Non refundable/Non-adjustable) by means of draft in favour of Excise and Taxation Commissioner, Haryana.
9. (a) Amount  
(b) Bank draft No. & date  
(c) Name of Bank  
(d) Signature of the applicant/partner/proprietor/director

10. Any applicant against whom there are any outstanding taxes/excise dues payable to the state of Haryana, shall not be eligible to apply unless he clears the dues to the satisfaction of the Excise and Taxation Commissioner, Haryana before submitting his application as prescribed. The application shall therefore, be accompanied with a **No Objection certificate/No dues certificate** issued by the Excise and Taxation Commissioner Haryana for this purpose.

11. The applicant who is awarded the contract for supply of country liquor shall duly pay up all taxes, fees and other levies of the Government of Haryana in time. If at any time during the contract period it is discovered that the approved distillery has failed to discharge its liability to pay any tax, fee or any other levies of the State of Haryana in time, then, the contract of supply for liquor shall be liable to be terminated solely on this ground. This will be without prejudice to any other liability under the law.

12. **The Government will not be obliged to allot molasses for supply of country liquor.** The distilleries shall have to supply country liquor in sand blasted new/ old glass, plastic (PET) bottles engraved with **HARYANA EXCISE**, in quarts (750 ml), pints (375 ml) and nips (180 ml).

13. The approved distilleries, shall open, licensed wholesale outlets of country liquor (L-13), at every district head quarter, on payment of annual license fee of Rs. Twenty five thousand, per L-13, per district, by means of bank drafts in favour of the Dy. Excise and Taxation Commissioner (Excise) of the respective district, and shall maintain stock of country liquor equal to five percent of the annual quota of the respective district. The **security** amount of Rs. One lakh, per licensed whole sale outlet of country liquor (L-13), per district, by means of bank drafts in favour of the Dy. Excise and Taxation Commissioner, (Excise)

of the respective district, shall be deposited for fulfilling the contract. The security money so deposited shall be retained by the department as security towards the performance of the contract. The amount of security/ the balance amount of security, after adjustments made, if any, shall be refunded at the successful completion of contract.

14. In the event of application being submitted on behalf of a partnership firm, it shall be signed separately by each partner thereof or by a partner who has been authorized by the remaining partners to sign on their behalf after having obtained power of attorney from the concerned co-partner(s) and in case of a company, by the authorized representative

15. The application should be typed or written in ink.

16. All cuttings/overwritings in the application shall be attested by the applicant under his/their signature/date.

17. The applicant will give complete addresses of its sister concerns if any, alongwith name of partners with their complete addresses to the extent of share.

18. The applicant shall have to submit a copy of the license issued by the excise authority of the concerned State certifying installed capacity of the distillery.

19. The approved distillers shall have to strictly adhere to the provisions of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, the rules framed thereunder and such other policies/instructions, which are in operation from time to time.

**20. Import duty on country liquor and rectified spirit for manufacturing country liquor shall be charged at Re. 0.50 per proof litre and Re 0.50 per proof litre respectively.**

21. Distilleries located out side the State of Haryana having exported country liquor to other States shall have to furnish a certificate of successful completion/ execution of contract of supply of country liquor from the Excise Commissioner of the concerned State stating that the supplier had completed the contract satisfactorily and that he did not make any default.

**22 The distilleries must indicate monthly quantities proposed to be offered for supply of country liquor.**

**23 The supply of country liquor in quarts, pints and nips size shall be as per demand of the licensed retail liquor outlets (L-14A) and prescribed by the department in the ratio of 3:2:2 respectively.**

**24. The approved distilleries shall have to be prepared to commence supply with effect from 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2006 so as to enable the licensed retail liquor outlets (L-14A) to start the sales w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> of April 2006.**

25 The approved distilleries shall get the labels approved by the department for the year 2006-2007 before making supplies on payment of label fee.

26. The distilleries shall use 3 ply corrugated boxes having bursting strength of 5 kilogram per cm square for packing of 12 quarts (750 ml) or 24 pints (375 ml) or 50 nips (180 ml) each. Quarts size empty pet bottles shall weigh between thirty to thirty two grams. Officer-in-charge of distillery /L-13 wholesale outlet depot in Haryana may get it tested from an authorised laboratory.

27 The distiller shall use pilfer proof seals.

28. The distilleries shall have pot stills installed and shall be capable of manufacturing double distilled, spiced, pot, country liquor of fifty degree proof strength.

29. The approved distilleries shall have to get the Govt. Excise Officer/Officials posted at their distilleries and wholesale vends of country liquor (L-13) for the purpose of ensuring the due observance of excise laws and the rules/regulations/policies/instructions made thereunder.

30. As and when required, samples of the raw material, spirit, packing material and country liquor shall be drawn/collected for analysis at the option of the state excise authorities, it shall be the duty of the authorized persons working in the distilleries and wholesale country liquor vends (L-13) to extend such help as is required for this purpose.

**31. The approved distilleries shall be personally responsible for any act of commission or omission regarding quality and supply of country liquor and maintenance of the licensed whole sale outlet of CL (L-13).**

32. The approved distilleries shall have to adhere to the excise rules/ regulations/ policies/ instructions of the exporting State as well as the State of Haryana.

33. A detailed statement indicating the actual production and supply of country liquor during the last five years duly authenticated by the excise authorities of the exporting State in which the distillation plant is located shall be attached with the application form. In case of a new distillery the production statement for the last year shall be attached.

34. Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Haryana will have the right to reject all or any of the application without assigning any reason in public interest.

35. No applications will be considered until and unless all the documents are properly attested / signed by the authorised signatory bearing his stamp and designation.

36. The applications will be regarded to be merely offers and shall be open to acceptance in whole or in part or parts at the discretion of Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Haryana in public interest.

37. In the event of application being accepted, it will be converted into a contract which will be governed by the conditions contained in this application form and its enclosures.

38. If any dispute shall arise in connection with or arising out of this instrument and in respect of modification termination of contract except offences/ violations/ contraventions for which penalties have been specifically provided under the Punjab Excise Act 1914 as applicable to the State of Haryana, Rules, Regulations & Orders made thereunder, shall be referred for arbitration to an officer appointed by the Haryana Government and his decision shall be final & binding and where the matter involves a claim, the amount if any awarded in such arbitration shall be recoverable in respect of the matters so referred.

39. The State Government (hereinafter referred to as "Government") shall after examining the response to the public notice in terms of valid applications received, quantities offered, manufacturing capacity and the reputation of the distilleries and any other appropriate parameter, decide to approve the distilleries for supply of country liquor, which the distilleries would be under obligation to supply.

**40. The applications shall be received in the office of the Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Haryana, by 3.00 p.m. upto 11.3.2006.**

**41.** The applications shall be enclosed in a properly sealed envelope addressed to the Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Haryana, by designation (and not by name). The applications shall be superscribed “applications for the supply of Country Liquor during the year 2006-2007.
