**NOTICE FOR INVITING APPLICATIONS FOR THE ALLOTMENT OF RETAIL SALE LICENSES OF COUNTRY LIQUOR (L-14A) AND INDIAN MADE FOREIGN LIQUOR (L-2), AND GRANT OF WHOLESALE LICENSES OF COUNTRY LIQUOR, FOR DISTILLERIES ONLY (L-13), AND WHOLESALE LICENSES OF IMFL, FOR GENERAL PUBLIC, (L-1), AND BAR /CLUB LICENSES (L-4/L-5 & L-12C) FOR THE YEAR 2006-2007 IN THE STATE OF HARYANA.**

### **PART-A for retail licensed outlets of IMFL (L-2) and CL (L-14A)**

It is notified for the information of general public that the applications for a maximum of **2800** retail sale licensed outlets of country liquor (L-14A) and **1600** retail sale licensed outlets of Indian Made Foreign Liquor (L-2) are invited in the State of Haryana for the year 2006-2007 on the following terms and conditions.

1. The applications are to be furnished separately for the retail licensed outlets of country liquor and Indian Made Foreign Liquor which have been earmarked locality wise.
2. An applicant can apply for more than one licensed outlet.
3. The lists of eligible and ineligible applicants separately shall be displayed at a conspicuous place in the offices of the Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioners(Excise) of the respective districts three days before the allotment of licensed outlets / draw of lots.
4. The license fees and quotas of the retail licensed outlets of country liquor and IMFL separately have been fixed. The details of these may be had from the Deputy Excise & Taxation Commissioners(Excise) of the respective districts.

5. The allotment or the draw of lots in case of more than one eligible applicant applying for the same retail licensed outlets, the license will be granted by a draw of lots to be conducted by the Committee consisting of the Deputy Commissioner, Deputy Excise & Taxation Commissioner(Excise), Deputy Excise & Taxation Commissioner(Sales Tax) and the Excise and Taxation Officer (Excise) or Assistant Excise and Taxation Officer (Excise) of the respective district in the presence of the applicants who wish to be present on 17.3.2006.
6. After the allotment/draw of lots, the list of successful allottees shall be displayed at a conspicuous place in the offices of the Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioners(Excise) in the respective districts.
7. All the licenses shall be granted by the Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioners(Excise) of the districts on behalf of the Collector after the approval of the Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Haryana, who reserves the right to cancel any allotment of a vend / vends without assigning any reason in the public interest.
8. The successful allottee shall be required to deposit a security of twenty percent of the annual license fee of the licensed outlets, out of which, five percent of the license fee shall have to be deposited on the day of draw of lots, five percent of the license fee within seven days of the allotment/draw of lots on or before 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2006; which ever is earlier, another ten percent of the license fee by 7<sup>th</sup> of April, 2006 and the remaining eighty percent in eight equal monthly installments payable by fifteenth day of the following month. In the case of companies the total annual license fee shall be paid on the day of draw of lots.
9. No interest shall be payable on the security amount.
10. No sub-licensed outlets will be allowed.
11. One ahata per licensed outlet of country liquor and IMFL may be allowed on application, in urban areas only, on depositing 1% (one percent) of the annual license fee of the licensed outlet or Rs. Twenty Five Thousand which ever is higher.
12. The excise duty @ Rs. 5/- (Rs. Five) per proof litre on country liquor, Rs. 25/- (Rs. Twenty five) per proof litre on IMFS and Rs. 12/- (i.e. Re. 1/-

PBL as Excise Duty & Rs. 11.00 PBL as permit fee) per bulk litre on beer shall be levied.

13. Beer shall be sold in retail from L-2 licensed outlets only.
14. An applicant shall have to submit an affidavit containing following information along with the application.
  - a) Name and Father's Name.
  - b) Residential and business address.
  - c) Details of unencumbered immovable properties and Bank accounts in his name.

Verification of particulars would be made in respect of the successful allottee before the licence is actually granted.

The successful allottee shall furnish his two latest photographs, alongwith proof of residence in the form of copies of voter identity card/ ration card. All the documents must be attested by a gazetted officer, duly stamped with his name and designation.

To ensure that a successful allottee for a licence does not fall under the purview of clauses (a) and (b) of order 7 of the Punjab Intoxicants License and Sale Orders, 1956, he shall, before he starts his business, be required to file an affidavit on a non-judicial stamp paper of the value of Rs. 3/- to the effect that he has not been convicted of any non-bailable offence by a criminal court or of any offence under the Punjab Excise or the Opium Act, the East Punjab Opium Smoking Act, 1948, the East Punjab Molasses (Control) Act, 1948, the Indian Power Alcohol Act, 1948 applicable to Haryana or the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. The successful allottee shall also file an affidavit before opening of the licensed outlets to the effect that he is not a defaulter and has paid all past dues of excise revenue in Haryana. The failure to furnish the affidavit prescribed herein or furnish false affidavit shall be sufficient ground for cancellation of license, which shall be reallocated at his cost and risk.

15. The prescribed application forms can be obtained from the offices of the respective Deputy Excise & Taxation Commissioners(Excise) on payment of Rs. 5000/- (Rs. Five Thousand only) (Non-refundable and Non-adjustable)

in cash against proper receipt. The Deputy Excise & Taxation Commissioner (Excise) shall authentication the application forms, before issue, with his signature and official stamp.

16. The applications in the prescribed proforma alongwith the fee of Rs. One lakh only, in cash or by bank draft, against proper receipt, per application, per licensed outlet, adjustable/refundable, and the supporting documents, as required, must reach the office of the Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioners (Excise) of the respective districts, by 3.00 p.m. upto 11.3.2006.

**17. All the payments have to be made preferably by means of bank drafts in favour of the Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioners(Excise) of the respective districts.**

18. It will be open for the distilleries located in the State and those distilleries which are located within 200 kms of the limits of the State, to apply for the supply of country liquor.

***After the approval of the Excise & Taxation Commissioner, the approved distilleries shall be required to open wholesale licensed liquor outlets of country liquor (L-13) on an annual license fee of Rs. Twenty Five thousand and a security amounting to Rs. 1.00 lakh per outlet per district in every district head quarter of the State to maintain regular and ready supply of ordinary spiced country liquor to the licensed retail liquor outlets of country liquor (L-14A).***

19. The retail outlets of country liquor (L-14A) shall receive supplies of ordinary spiced country liquor from the wholesale outlet of country liquor (L-13).

20. The retail outlets of IMFL (L-2) shall receive supplies of liquor from the wholesale outlet of IMFL (L-1).

21. The uniform annual license fee of bars and clubs (L-4/L-5 and L-12C) shall be Rs. Six Lakhs.

**Part-B For wholesale vends of IMFL (L-1)**

**L-1 License (wholesale and retail licensed outlets of foreign liquor to trade only)**

1. Licenses for wholesale licensed outlets of Indian Made Foreign Liquor (L-1) will be granted to the general public subject to the conditions of eligibility.

*Detailed information regarding categorization of the licensed outlets, license fee, various levies on liquor, conditions of the licenses and number of retail sale licensed outlets locality-wise etc. can be obtained from the offices of Deputy Excise & Taxation Commissioners (Excise) of the districts concerned on any working day between 9.00 AM to 5.00 PM.*
