NOTICE FOR INVITING APPLICATIONS FOR THE ALLOTMENT OF RETAIL SALE LICENSES OF COUNTRY LIQUOR (L-14A) AND INDIAN MADE FOREIGN LIQUOR (L-2) FOR GENERAL PUBLIC, THE YEAR 2008-2009 IN THE STATE OF HARYANA.

Retail licensed outlets of IMFL (L-2) and CL (L-14A)

It is notified for the information of general public that the applications for retail sale licensed outlets of country liquor (L-14A) and retail sale licensed outlets of Indian Made Foreign Liquor (L-2) have been invited in the State of Haryana for the year 2008-2009.

1. The applications shall be entertained in the prescribed form only which is available in all the offices of Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioner (Excise) of the State. The application form is priced Rs 5000/- only. The validity of application form is limited to Retail Vend of the District from where it has been purchased. The cost of application form i.e Rs 5000/- is non refundable and non adjustable.
2. ***The sale of application forms shall continue on Saturday also .i.e 1-3-2008 from all offices concerned.***
3. The applications are required to be furnished separately for each retail licensed outlet of country liquor and Indian Made Foreign Liquor. The list of vends with details shall be provided with application forms. It is also available on the website of the Department i.e. ***Haryanatax.com*** and all DETC Excise offices of the Department.
4. The license fee, quota, location and command area for each retail licensed outlet of country liquor and IMFL has been fixed separately and is mentioned in the list of vends.
5. An applicant can apply for more than one licensed outlet.
6. The applicant shall be required to submit filled application forms in the office of concerned DETC Excise along with Rs. 1 lac as earnest money in case of vends with license fee less than Rs 50 Lacs and Rs 2 Lac for all other

- vends, to be adjusted towards payment of security in the case of successful allottees and to be refunded in the case of unsuccessful applicants.
7. The list of eligible and ineligible applicants shall be displayed separately at a conspicuous place in the office of the Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioner (Excise) of the respective district three days before the day of draw of lot.
 8. The allotment shall be made on an application and in case of more than one application, through transparent draw of lot. The draw of lot, if necessary shall be conducted by a committee consisting of Deputy Commissioner, a representative of Excise and Taxation Commissioner, Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioner (Excise), Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioner (ST) and Excise and Taxation Officer (Excise) or Assistant Excise and Taxation Officer (Excise) of the respective district in the presence of the applicants who wish to be present on the date of draw.
 9. All licenses, whether for wholesale or for retail sale, shall be granted subject to the provisions of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 and the Rules/ Regulations/ Instructions/ Policies framed there under from time to time as applicable to the State of Haryana.
 10. All allotments of licenses shall be subject to the approval of the Excise & Taxation Commissioner. The Financial Commissioner may reject, without assigning any reason, any allotment in the public interest as the case may be, within 10 days of the date of draw of lot.
 11. The successful allottee shall be required to deposit a security of twenty percent of the annual license fee of the licensed outlet, out of which, five percent of the license fee shall have to be deposited on the day of draw of lots, five percent of the license fee within seven days of the allotment/draw of lots on or before 31st March, 2008; which ever is earlier, and another ten percent of the license fee by 7th of April, 2008.
 12. No interest shall be payable on the security amount.
 13. The excise duty @ Rs. 6/- (Rs. Six) per proof litre on country liquor, Rs. 25/- (Rs. Twenty five) per proof litre on IMFS and Rs. 12/- per bulk litre on beer shall be levied.
 14. Permit fee shall be levied on Country Liquor and IMFS @ Rs 1 per PL and Beer @ Rs 5 per case in accordance with the policy 2008-09.

15. Beer shall be sold in retail from L-2 licensed outlet and from rural L-14A licensed outlet where there is no L-2 licensed outlet.
16. Verification of particulars would be made in respect of the successful allottees before the license is actually granted.
17. The applicant shall furnish his two latest photographs, alongwith proof of residence in the form of copies of voter identity card/ ration card.
18. All successful allottees, before the start of operation of vend, shall be required to file an affidavit on a non-judicial stamp paper of the value of Rs. 3/- to the effect that he has not been convicted of any non-bailable offence by a criminal court or of any offence under the Punjab Excise or the Opium Act, the East Punjab Opium Smoking Act, 1948, the East Punjab Molasses (Control) Act, 1948, the Indian Power Alcohol Act, 1948 applicable to Haryana or the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. The successful allottee shall also file an affidavit before opening of the licensed outlets to the effect that he is not a defaulter and has paid all past dues of excise revenue in Haryana. The failure to furnish the affidavit prescribed herein or furnish false affidavit shall be sufficient ground for cancellation of license, which shall be reallocated at his cost and risk.
19. The application in the prescribed proforma alongwith the earnest money by preferably by bank draft or cash, against proper receipt, per application, per licensed outlet, adjustable/refundable, and the supporting documents, as required, must reach the office of the Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioners (Excise) of the respective districts as per schedule given below:-

(iii)	Draw of lots of Jind, Hisar, Fatehabad, Sirsa, Kaithal, Karnal, Kurukshetra, Ambala, Jagadhri & Panchkula	9-3-2008
(iv)	Draw of lots of Faridabad, Gurgaon, Mewat, Rewari, Narnaul, Jhajjar, Sonipat, Panipat, Rohtak & Bhiwani	10-3-2008
20. **All payments have to be made preferably by means of bank draft in favour of the Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioners(Excise) of the respective district.**

21. The retail outlet of country liquor (L-14A) shall receive supplies of ordinary spiced country liquor from the wholesale outlet of country liquor (L-13) of the respective district.
22. The retail outlet of IMFL (L-2) shall receive supplies of liquor from the wholesale outlet of IMFL (L-1) of the respective district.
